At Greater Toledo Community Foundation, in addition to leading a staff of nineteen in their primary role of responsive grantmaker, he has led his team in a variety of other civic roles such as educator, catalyst and convener on key community issues, making available his expertise and that of his professional staff to a wide range of community efforts. His Foundation team directs annual grantmaking and gifting in the region, making Greater Toledo Community Foundation the largest philanthropic organization in northwest Ohio.

To help secure the future for our children and grandchildren, Keith has taken a leadership role and is collaborating with partners on several initiatives including the **Old Jeep Neighborhood “Overland Solar Project”** and **TutorSMART, high-quality Pre-K programming and other education initiatives.**

He currently serves on the Boards of the Imagination Station, Regional Growth Partnership, The Rotary Club of Toledo and Philanthropy Ohio; is a member of the Chronicle of Philanthropy Advisory Committee; Chair of the Ohio Community Foundation CEO Committee; and was appointed a member of The Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland's inaugural Community Advisory Council; as well as other local and national committees and boards. Keith continues to speak locally and nationally regarding issues affecting local philanthropy.
