Fifty Years of Funding Futures

The <u>Greater Toledo Community Foundation</u> in January announced that it will distribute \$600,000 in funding in 2023 to local nonprofit organizations in celebration of its 50th anniversary, in addition to an annual average grant distribution of approximately \$18 million. The Foundation also announced a 12-month campaign, "<u>Fifty Years of Funding Futures</u>," along with a 2023 calendar of community events and programs centered on honoring the past, celebrating the present and equipping future generations for continued community impact.
